Born on 30<sup>th</sup> May, 1988, **Shri Uday Kumar** hails from Chhapra, Bihar. Shri Uday Kumar exhibited exceptional courage and determination by successfully climbing Mount Rhenock (16,500 feet) in Kanchenjunga National Park of West Sikkim and displayed 780 Sq ft Indian flag.

In recognition of his outstanding achievements and contribution in the field of adventure, **Shri Uday Kumar** is presented with the Tenzing Norgay National Adventure Award 2023 for Land Adventure.

Born on 27<sup>th</sup> April, 1998, **Ms Sayani Das** hails from Purba Bardhaman, West Bengal. She swam the English Channel (England to France) in 14 hrs 08min, Rottnest channel in 6 hrs. 42 min, Molokai channel (Molokai to O'ahu) in 18 hrs 50 min and Catalina Channel (Catalina to Mainland) in 12 hrs. 46 min.

In recognition of her outstanding achievement and contribution in the field of adventure, **Ms Sayani Das i**s presented with the Tenzing Norgay National Adventure Award 2023 for Water Adventure.

Born on 10<sup>th</sup> April, 1982, **Shri Jithin Malayilakathutt Vijayan** hails from Kochi, Kerala. He holds the record for the longest freefall in flat flying which is 2 minutes 47 seconds; skydiving from 42,431 feet altitude with Indian flag and greatest distance Freefall with Indian flag from altitude of 36,929 feet. He also skydived for 18 consecutive days.

In recognition of his outstanding achievement and contribution in the field of adventure, **Shri Jithin Malayilakathutt Vijayan** is presented with the Tenzing Norgay National Adventure Award 2023 for Air Adventure.

Born on 2<sup>nd</sup> March, 1965, **Shri Umesh Mallikarjun Zirpe**, hails from Pune, Maharashtra. He has successfully led expeditions to Mount Everest, Mount Manaslu, Mount Lhotse, Mount Kanchenjunga, Mount Annapurna and Mount Dhaulagiri and also guided young generation through different Mountaineering campaigns. He is also a recipient of highest sports award in Maharashtra "Shiv Chhatrapati State Adventure Sports Award" during 2013-14.

In recognition of his sustained commitment, significant contribution and unmatched spirit of adventure, **Shri Umesh Mallikarjun Zirpe** is presented with the Tenzing Norgay National Adventure Award 2023 for Life Time Achievement.
